


## MDL Patient Portal Login Guide

If you have been tested at a facility that uses WSU's Molecular Diagnostics Lab to process their tests, and are trying to access your results via email, this guide outlines the process for you.

### Creating your Account from Email

#### Step 1.

You will receive an initial email from [mdlsender@wichita.edu](mailto:mdlsender@wichita.edu), at the email address you provided, containing a link to set up your account. Each link is specific to the individual and will not work for others. Click the link to confirm your identity.



#### Step 2.

If this is your first time setting up an account, please input your Date of Birth, Zip Code, 4-digit PIN provided at time of testing, and click next.





SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19)

RESULT SUMMARY

SARS-CoV-2 Negative

INTERPRETATION

This SARS-CoV-2 assay is a real-time RT-PCR test for the detection of viral nucleic acid.

POSITIVE: Results indicate active infection with SARS\_CoV-2. Specificity of the method is >99%.

NEGATIVE: No SARS-CoV-2 nucleic acid detected. Sensitivity of method is > 99% for 10 genomic copies of SARS-CoV-2 per reaction. If SARS-CoV-2 is still suspected based on clinical findings, history or epidemiologic information, re-testing of a new specimen should be considered.

If you have not tested before and want to pre-register for a test, follow these steps:

### Step 3.

Fill in all the required fields, tan boxes are required. Then select the **Next** button. The password must be a minimum of 6 characters, at least one uppercase letter, and have at least on numeric digit.

Under Communication Preference you can select to be notified that your results are ready by email, text, or both. Keep in mind you will not receive your results via SMS text message, you will still need to log in on a computer once you receive a text message informing you your results are ready.




## Step 5.

## Other Features of your Account

The **Update Information** button can be used to update personal information such as your address, name, etc. You will not need to use it every time you test, only if your information has changed. Please note that if you modify your information, it will not change the information on past results, only for future tests. If you change your information, your testing code will not change, so you can bring that same testing code with you to the testing site each time you test. To view that code again, you can also select **View Testing Code**.
