


## MDL Patient Portal Log In Guide

Hello! If you have been tested at a facility that uses WSU’s Molecular Diagnostics Lab to process their tests and are trying to access your results via email, this guide outlines the process for you.

### Step 1.

You will receive an initial email from [mdlsender@wichita.edu](mailto:mdlsender@wichita.edu) at the email address you provided containing a link to set up your account. Each link is specific to the individual and will not work for others. Click the link to confirm your identity.



### Step 2.

If this is your first time setting up an account please input your Date of Birth, Zip Code, 4-digit PIN provided at time of testing, and click next. If you already have an account and want to link a new test to it, put in your information and click where it says “this link” above the next button.
