


Neonatal A-Clip



About

The Neonatal A-Clip replaces traditional taping methods for securing respiratory tubes in the NICU, making intubation faster and more efficient. It enhances the baby's and family's experience by reducing discomfort and eliminating the need for adhesive tape and harsh chemicals.



Market Opportunity

As the number of preterm and low-birth-weight babies increase, the necessity for neonatal respiratory devices and neonatal equipment continue to increase. The neonatal A-Clip enables securing of an ET tube for enhanced stability and lower risk of infection.

Target customers include neonatal care providers whether in a hospital or other medical settings. Neonatal care requires technologies to ensure optimal safety and precision which our technology is able to provide.



The market opportunity extends to an expected growth of \$3 million by 2032. Such significant market growth further highlights the necessity of enhanced neonatal respiratory devices to aid in neonatal care services.

Potential Applications

The neonatal A-Clip enables stabilization of an incubation tube which decreases risk of infection, and increases stability of tubing to make the experience more comfortable and safe for patients.
