The Aerospace industry was hit hard in 2008, when Absolute Dimensions went from their highest month ever to their worst month ever, back to back! After hitting a new low in sales in 2009, they were able to go through KSBDC's Strategic Planning in 2010, which brought them together as a team. Everyone had similar goals but they weren't headed in the same direction. Through Strategic Planning, they focused on specific steps for success, such as going lean and insuring on-time delivery. By implementing these steps, they were able to outlast their competition. Over the past four years, they increased sales by an average of over 55% per year, and they now employ 24.
