



OVERVIEW

The **Division of Student Affairs** comprises of five units¹: Auxiliary Services, Student Life, Assessment & Retention, Wellness, and Operations. This infographic provides a quick snapshot of the data and accomplishments from various departments² within the units that improved the overall student experience at Wichita State University.
