# Tips For Success In Online Learning

Taking online courses can be challenging for students who prefer taking class in person. We have come up with some tips and strategies to help students succeed in the online learning environment.

1. Create a productive learning workspace – set up a space in your home at a desk or table to work and stay organized.

2. Eliminate distractions – find a quiet place to study and keep your TV and phone turned off to avoid interruptions. Try to eliminate anything that will take your focus off of your studies.



Practice time management – set a schedule for completing and reviewing assignments and stick to the schedule.
Create a virtual study group – when you can't meet socially distanced with classmates, form a study group and meet via Zoom or Teams.

5. Communicate with your instructors ASAP if you are having difficulties – it can be harder to ask your instructors for help when you are not physically in the classroom. If you are needing help, ask right away to avoid falling behind.

Don't miss out on our upcoming workshops. All workshops are held through Zoom and will begin at 1:00PM on the dates they are scheduled.



### FAFSA Opens October 1<sup>st</sup>!

Submissions for the 2021-2022 FAFSA begins October 1<sup>st</sup>. Wichita State's priority date for FAFSA is December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Early FAFSA submission gives you priority consideration for financial assistance and additional time to make informed financial decisions. Prepare for the FAFSA by making sure you know the difference between the different types of financial aid which includes scholarships, grants, work study, and loans. Meet with your TRIO DSS advisor to complete the FAFSA any time in October to receive financial literacy workshop credit.



#### FAFSA Prep Checklist

Make the FAFSA submission process easier by completing the following:

- Bookmark the FAFSA website: www.fafsa.gov
- Know your FAFSA login and password
- Gather your 2019 tax information

- Obtain parents' 2019 tax information (if applicable)
- Download the FAFSA app for your phone
- Make an appointment with your TRIO DSS advisor
