Assisting GTAs

- Help faculty with preparing lectures and course materials
- Development and/or monitoring of examinations
- Facilitate group discussions or laboratory experiments
- Grade examinations (but not assign end of semester grades)



Direct Instruction GTAs

- "Stand-alone" teachers ->
 instructor of record
- Preparation of course lectures, laboratory assignments & course materials

- Title IX and more!




#4 Academic Honesty


