I agree to abide by all parking rules and regulations. (Reminder: Red parking stalls posted as restricted or reserved spaces are enforced 24/7.) I understand that the paid registration of my license plates and the purchase of ePermit serves as my permission to park on campus.

- If you have a state disabled parking placard or plate, you may park in accessible parking stalls. If those stalls are full, you may park in any available stall not posted as restricted or reserved.
- Only one of your registered vehicles may be parked on campus at a time.
- Wichita State University uses License Plate Recognition technology to enforce parking areas.
- You must park your vehicle so that the license plate is visible and unobscured when parked.
- If you do not have front license plates, then you may not back into a parking stall.
- ePermits are valid Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
