MASTER AGREEMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. Scope: This addendum covers the Master Agreement #NASPO 00819 led by the State of Washington for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State authorized by that State's statutes to utilize State contracts with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement Official.
- Participation: This NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement may be used by all state agencies, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the State of Kansas. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official

4. Participating Entity Modifications Or Additions To The Master Agreement

These modifications or additions apply only to actions and relationships within the Participating Entity. [x] The following changes are modifying or supplementing the Master Agreement terms and conditions.

- a) The laws of the State of Kansas shall govern this Participating Addendum.
- b) State of Kansas Contractual Provisions Attachment, DA-146a attached and incorporated into this Participating Addendum as Attachment A will have prior precedence over the Order of Precedence for the Master Agreement (00819).
- Travel expenses if applicable, shall be reimbursed under the same rates and conditions as noted in the "Employee Travel Expense Reimbursement Handbook" found at: https://admin.ks.gov/offices/accountsreports/state-employees/state-employees-travel-center unless otherwise agreed upon with the Purchasing Entity.

- d) Leasing is outside the scope of the NASPO ValuePoint Agreement and this Participating Addendum.
- e) Business Procurement Card: Agencies may use a Business Procurement Card (Visa) in lieu of a state warrant to pay for its purchases. No additional charges will be allowed for using the card.
- Reports:

The Contractor shall submit an annual report to the Division of Purchases for all acquisitions, less returned product ("actual, net invoice sales"), made from this Participating Addendum. This report should include as a minimum the agency name, quantity, description, and amount. The report will be provided electronically. The report is to be sent to: reports@ks.gov. The report shall be submitted by March 31st the following calendar year.

g) Rebates:

The contractor shall provide rebates in the following manner:

- Prompt Payment Incentive:
 - Each Participating Entity will receive a basis point (percentage) of its Quarterly Total Volume based on the entity's average speed of pay. Ranging from .25bps to 20bps (as written in the NASPO master contract on page 33). This incentive is paid out guarterly, 2 months in arrears.
- Standard Volume Incentive:
 - Each Participating Entity will receive a basis point (percentage) of its quarterly standard sales volume. The formula for calculating the Standard Volume Incentive is:
 - Quarterly Total Volume x basis points = Quarterly Standard Volume Incentive.
 - Basis Points Offered: 170 basis points (1.70%)
 - This incentive is paid out quarterly, 2 months in arrears.
- National Annual Volume Incentive:
 - A check shall be sent payable to the State of Kansas Office of Procurement and Contracts for an amount equal to the National Annual Volume. The State of Kansas will receive an incentive based on the total National Annual Volume (total annual sales for all Participating States/Participating Entities). The formula for calculating the National Annual Sales Volume
 - National Annual Volume (for all Fleet products) x basis points = National Annual Sales Volume Incentive. This incentive range is 10bps to 30bps, depending on the total National Annual Volume.
 - This incentive is paid out 2 months in arrears.
- h) This contract is not an exclusive contract. The State of Kansas is not precluded from the purchase of goods and services from other sources.
- A State of Kansas Tax Clearance Certificate is required to execute this contract.
- The contractor shall sign and submit a "Policy Regarding Sexual Harassment Acknowledgment form" per Executive Order 18-04. This form is required to execute this contract.

1.1 Important

The parties agree that the following provisions are hereby incorporated into the contract to which it is attached and made a part thereof, said contract being the date of final signature or September 8, 2025, whichever occurs later.

1.2. Terms Herein Controlling Provisions

It is expressly agreed that the terms of each and every provision in this attachment shall prevail and control over the terms of any other conflicting provision in any other document relating to and a part of the contract in which this attachment is incorporated. Any terms that conflict or could be interpreted to conflict with this attachment are nullified.

1.3. Kansas Law and Venue

This contract shall be subject to, governed by, and construed according to the laws of the State of Kansas, and jurisdiction and venue of any suit in connection with this contract shall reside only in courts located in the State of Kansas.

1.4. Termination Due to Lack of Funding Appropriation

If, in the judgment of the Director of Accounts and Reports, Department of Administration, sufficient funds are not appropriated to continue the function performed in this agreement and for the payment of the charges hereunder, State may terminate this agreement at the end of its current fiscal year.

State agrees to give written notice of termination to contractor at least thirty (30) days prior to the end of its current fiscal year and shall give such notice for a greater period prior to the end of such fiscal year as may be provided in this contract, except that such notice shall not be required prior to ninety (90) days before the end of such fiscal year. Contractor shall have the right, at the end of such fiscal year, to take possession of any equipment provided State under the contract. State will pay to the contractor all regular contractual payments incurred through the end of such fiscal year, plus contractual charges incidental to the return of any such equipment. Upon termination of the agreement by State, title to any such equipment shall revert to contractor at the end of the State's current fiscal year. The termination of the contract pursuant to this paragraph shall not cause any penalty to be charged to the agency or the contractor.

1.5. Disclaimer of Liability

No provision of this contract will be given effect that attempts to require the State of Kansas or its agencies to defend, hold harmless, or indemnify any contractor or third party for any acts or omissions. The liability of the State of Kansas is defined under the Kansas Tort Claims Act (K.S.A. 75-6101, et seg.).

1.6. Anti-Discrimination Clause

The contractor agrees: (a) to comply with the Kansas Act Against Discrimination (K.S.A. 44 1001, et seq.) and the Kansas Age Discrimination in Employment Act (K.S.A. 44-1111, et seq.) and the applicable provisions of the Americans With Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 12101, et seq.) (ADA), and Kansas Executive Order No. 19-02, and to not discriminate against any person because of race, color, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, religion, national origin, ancestry, age, military or veteran status, disability status, marital or family status, genetic information, or political affiliation that is unrelated to the person's ability to reasonably perform the duties of a particular job or position; (b) to include in all solicitations or advertisements for employees, the phrase "equal opportunity employer"; (c) to comply with the reporting requirements set out at K.S.A. 44-1031 and K.S.A. 44-1116; (d) to include those provisions in every subcontract or purchase order so that they are binding upon such subcontractor or vendor; (e) that a failure to comply with the reporting requirements of (c) above or if the contractor is found guilty of any violation of such acts by the Kansas Human Rights Commission, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be cancelled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration; (f) Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal antidiscrimination laws and regulations; (g) Contractor agrees all hiring must be on the basis of individual merit and qualifications, and discrimination or harassment of persons for the reasons stated above is prohibited; and (h) if it is determined that the contractor has violated the provisions of any portion of this paragraph, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be canceled, terminated, or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration.

1.7. Acceptance of Contract

This contract shall not be considered accepted, approved or otherwise effective until the statutorily required approvals and certifications have been given.

1.8. Arbitration, Damages, Warranties

Notwithstanding any language to the contrary, no interpretation of this contract shall find that the State or its agencies have agreed to binding arbitration, or the payment of damages or penalties. Further, the State of Kansas and its agencies do not agree to pay attorney fees, costs, or late payment charges beyond those available under the Kansas Prompt Payment Act (K.S.A. 75-6403), and no provision will be given effect that attempts to exclude, modify, disclaim or otherwise attempt to limit any damages available to the State of Kansas or its agencies at law, including but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

1.9. Representative's Authority to Contract

By signing this contract, the representative of the contractor thereby represents that such person is duly authorized by the contractor to execute this contract on behalf of the contractor and that the contractor agrees to be bound by the provisions thereof.

1.10. Responsibility for Taxes

The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be responsible for, nor indemnify a contractor for, any federal, state, or local taxes which may be imposed or levied upon the subject matter of this contract.

1.11. Insurance

The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to property or any other subject matter relating to this contract, nor shall this contract require them to establish a "self-insurance" fund to protect against any such loss or damage. Subject to the provisions of the Kansas Tort Claims Act (K.S.A. 75-6101, et seq.), the contractor shall bear the risk of any loss or damage to any property in which the contractor holds title.

1.12. Information

No provision of this contract shall be construed as limiting the Legislative Division of Post Audit from having access to information pursuant to K.S.A. 46-1101, et seq.

1.13. The Eleventh Amendment

"The Eleventh Amendment is an inherent and incumbent protection with the State of Kansas and need not be reserved, but prudence requires the State to reiterate that nothing related to this contract shall be deemed a waiver of the Eleventh Amendment."

1.14. Campaign Contributions / Lobbying

Funds provided through a grant award or contract shall not be given or received in exchange for the making of a campaign contribution. No part of the funds provided through this contract shall be used to influence or attempt to influence an officer or employee of any State of Kansas agency or a member of the Legislature regarding any pending legislation or the awarding, extension, continuation, renewal, amendment or modification of any government contract, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement.
