January 24-25	First day of Saturday/Sunday full-term classes
January 26	Last day to add full-semester classes or change sections of the same course
February 2 (Monday)	LAST DAY FOR REGISTERED STUDENTS TO MAKE PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS before late fees are placed on those accounts without payment arrangements. Last day to drop a full-semester course and NOT have it appear on your record Last day to change your enrollment in a full-semester course from “credit” to “audit”

February 2	<u>LAST DAY TO DROP AND RECEIVE A 100% TUITION REFUND FOR FULL-SEMESTER COURSES</u> No additional partial refunds provided
February 16	20th day of classes—Official Regents’ reporting date <u>GRAD students:</u> Last day to file an “Application for Degree” (for Spring 2026) online
March 2	Tentative date for Summer and Fall 2026 Schedule of Courses to be available online
March 11	First 8-week courses end Mid-semester point
March 16-22	Spring Break
April 3	Last day to officially withdraw from a full-semester course with a “W”
April 6	Summer and Fall early registration begins
April 17	<u>GRAD students:</u> If graduating this Spring, last day to submit Request to Schedule Oral Defense
May 1	<u>GRAD students:</u> last day to hold oral defense if graduating at end of Spring
