Nov. 12 – Jan. 22	Spring web registration.
<b>Nov. 12 – Jan. 22</b>	<b>Students must make payment arrangements at time of enrollment. Bills will NOT be mailed. Account information is available online beginning the week of November 12.</b>

January 7-19	Spring PRESESSION
January 7	Late registration for PRESESSION only.

<b>January 22 (Tuesday)</b>	First day of late registration. <b>WEEKDAY AND EVENING CLASSES BEGIN.</b>
January 24 (Thursday)	<b>Senior citizen registration.</b>
January 26-27	First day of Saturday/Sunday classes
January 28	Last day for late registration for most full-term courses.
<b><u>DROPS &amp; ADDS (also see "NOTE" below)</u></b>	
<b>January 28</b>	<b>Last day to add full semester classes or change sections of the same course.</b>
<i><b>NOTE:</b> Classes that are less than the whole semester in length and that begin after the first week of the semester, on-line registration continues every day through the first day of class.</i>	
<b>February 4 (Monday)</b>	<b>LAST DAY FOR REGISTERED STUDENTS TO MAKE PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS before late fees are placed on those accounts without payment arrangements.</b>
<b>February 4</b>	<b>Last day to drop a course and NOT have it appear on your record.</b>
<b>February 4</b>	<b>Last day to change your enrollment in a course from "credit" to "audit," via drop/adds.</b>
<b>February 4</b>	<b><u>LAST DAY TO DROP AND RECEIVE A 100% TUITION REFUND FOR 16 WEEK COURSES.</u></b> No additional partial refunds provided.

**Classes and credit workshops meeting for a period other than the regular academic term will refund according to the schedule online. Refund on non-credit workshops will be made only on cancellations received 48 hours prior to the time of the scheduled workshop.**

February 18	20th day of classes—Official Regents' reporting date.
February 18	<u>GRAD students:</u> Last day to file an "Application for Degree" (for Spring 2019) online.
March 6	Tentative date for Summer and Fall 2019 Schedule of Courses to be available online.
<b>March 11-17</b>	<b>Spring BREAK – no classes</b>
March 18-22	First 8-week courses end this week.
March 20	Mid-semester point.
March 20-29	Mid-term grade reports available to students online.
<b>April 5</b>	<b>Last day to officially withdraw from a course with a "W" for 16 week courses.</b> <i><b>Note:</b> This deadline is different, but proportionately equivalent, for courses that are less than the full semester in length. It is based upon the length of the course, which is the elapsed time from the first class meeting to the last, regardless of how many class meetings there are during that time. The day that marks completion of two-thirds of the course's length is the deadline for withdrawal with a "W." Should that fall on a Saturday or Sunday, the deadline is the next business day.</i>
<b>April 8</b>	Tentative date for Summer and Fall early registration to begin.
April 16	Late fees are placed on delinquent accounts
April 19	<u>GRAD students:</u> If graduating this Spring, last day to submit Request to Schedule Oral Defense
May 3	<u>GRAD students:</u> last day to hold oral defense if graduating at end of Spring.
May 9	Last day of classes.
May 10	Study Day <u>GRAD students:</u> IF graduating at end of this Spring: Last day to remove incomplete grades. Last day to submit ETD. Last day to report completion of terminal program requirements. Last day to clear unmet financial obligations. Last day to report oral defense results.
May 11-16	Final examinations—see schedule online.
