that he/she is currently residing in Kansas at ADDRESS (PRINT) and has resided in Kansas since PHONE NUMBER

AND

that if he/she does not currently have lawful immigration status that he/she has filed, or his/her parents have filed, an application to legalize his/her status; or will file such an application as soon as he/she is eligible to do so;

OR

that if he/she does currently have a legal non-permanent immigration status (if so, indicate type of visa), and that he/she has filed an application to begin the process towards permanent residency or will file such an application as soon as he/she is eligible to do so.

further affirms and says that, to the best of his/her knowledge, he/she is NOT eligible to enroll in a public postsecondary educational institution located in another state and pay the tuition and fees required of residents of such state.

(Affiant also understands that proof of attendance at an accredited Kansas high school for three years, and proof of a Kansas high school diploma, must be presented with this affidavit.)

I certify that the information given on this Affidavit is accurate. I understand that falsified information can result in financial obligation (non-resident fees) to, and dismissal from, the University; and that making a false writing is a felony under Kansas law (K.S.A. 21-3711). I also understand that information from my application and other university records will be considered along with this affidavit.

Any individual who: (1) Files an affidavit which contains false information; (2) fails to file an application to legalize such person's immigration status within one year of becoming eligible; (3) fails to begin the process for permanent residency within one year of becoming eligible; or (4) fails to maintain an active application for permanent residency after filing therefore shall not be deemed a resident of the state of Kansas for the purpose of tuition and fees. In addition, such individual shall be required to repay the difference between the amount of fees and tuition actually paid and the amount such person would have paid as a nonresident of the state of Kansas, plus interest for the time such individual was enrolled as a resident pursuant to this section.

NOTE: Persons on F-1or M -1 visas are not eligible. Persons on B-1/B-2 visas cannot study in the U.S.
