Any individual who: (1) Files an affidavit which contains false information; (2) fails to file an application to legalize such person's immigration status within one year of becoming eligible; (3) fails to begin the process for permanent residency within one year of becoming eligible; or (4) fails to maintain an active application for permanent residency after filing therefore shall not be deemed a resident of the state of Kansas for the purpose of tuition and fees.
