BE IT ENACTED by the Student Senate that:

1. Amend Article I Section 4 of the Constitution to read:

- 3 The authority granted to the Association in this section is derived from and shall be
- 4 subject to the authority of the Board of Regents and the President of the University.
- 5 The authority granted to student organizations, through a grant of official recognition, is
- 6 derived from and shall be subject to the authority of the Association and its representative
- 7 bodies.

- 8 The Association, in order that it might perform its duties effectively, shall have the authority
- 9 to delegate its legislative, executive, and judicial authority to representative bodies. These
- 10 bodies shall have the authority to:
- 11 A. Prescribe procedure for the election and/or appointments of the membership of the
- 12 said bodies of the Association;
- 13 B. Extend official recognition to groups of students seeking privileges of a an official
- 14 recognized student organization (hereafter referred to as organizations);
- 15 C. Establish criteria and conduct a review for the granting and removal of said
- 16 recognition;
- 17 D. Levy reasonable penalties for Statutes;
- 18 E. Recommend to the Dean of Students Vice President of Student Affairs or designee
- 19 reasonable penalties for students who violate the Association's Statutes or University rules
- 20 and policies;
- 21 F. Reasonably provide for the execution of the Association's duties as prescribed in

- 22 Article I, Section 3, through the establishment of Statutes and the appointment of special or
- 23 regular committees with a specific grant of authority.

2. Amend Article III Section 2 of the Constitution to read:

- 25 The President and Vice President shall be elected on the same ballot, as a team, from the
- Association at an election held during the month of April.
- 27 The Treasurer shall be appointed by the President, said appointment subject to two-thirds
- 28 (2/3) ratification of the entire Senate, excluding vacant seats.
- 29 If the nominee has and maintains a 2.50 cumulative grade point average, Secretaries shall
- 30 take office upon nomination by the appropriate officer holder, subject to the consent of
- 31 the majority of the Student Senators present and voting, and shall retain said office until
- 32 the individual chooses to resign, loses student status, or is judged remiss or incompetent
- 33 in the discharge of their duties by the current holder of the office which passed on during
- 34 their Senate session, excluding vacated seats.
- 35 The tenure granted by these provisions shall not apply to Secretaries hired on a temporary
- or emergency basis during the months when the Senate is not in session

3. Amend Article III Section 5 of the Constitution to read:

- 38 The President of the Association shall have the following powers and duties:
- 39 A. To enforce the Statutes and administer the Resolutions of the Association;
- 40 B. To execute the policies of the Senate and the decisions of the Court;
- 41 C. To act as the official spokesperson for the Association;
- 42 D. To appoint the Court Justices as provided for in Article V, Section 1;
- 43 E. To appoint Association members to positions in pursuit of purposes of the
- 44 Association, subject to ratification by a majority vote of the Senate, unless otherwise
- 45 specified;

- 46 F. To recommend to the Senate any policy, which the individual considers to be in
- 47 pursuit of the purposes of the Association;
- 48 G. To veto and invalidate any action of the Senate within thirty (30) days which the
- 49 individual considers not in the interest of the Association. The Senate has seven (7) days in
- 50 which to act upon the President's veto. Said veto must be accompanied with a statement of

- 51 explanation in the form of an executive order;
- 52 H. Other duties as specified in the Association's Bylaws.

4. Amend Article III Section 8 of the Constitution to read:

- 54 The following will be grounds for removal of an Association officer:
- 55 A. The failure to maintain a 2.50 cumulative grade point average;
- 56 B. The failure to execute prescribed duties;
- 57 C. Others as established by the Code of Conduct and outlined in the Bylaws.
- 58 If an Association officer is charged with one or more of the grounds for removal, the
- 59 Senate shall review said officer's case, and may expel the officer by a two-thirds (2/3)
- vote of the entire Senate, excluding vacant seats.
- Recall Election: The Senate must call a special election of the Association within thirty
- 62 (30) days if presented with a petition to recall an Association officer signed by a number
- of the Association members equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of those voting in the last
- 64 Senate election. Such petition must be validated by the Association's Executive Secretary
- 65 Office Manager, or equivalent to, prior to public exposure and presentation. If the
- requisite number of signatures has not been obtained within thirty (30) days of said
- 67 validation and dating, the petition shall be null and void. If the requisite number of
- 68 signatures is obtained within thirty (30) days, the Association's Executive Secretary
- 69 Office Manager, or equivalent to, must validate the signatures as those of members of the
- 70 Association.

71 5. Amend Article IV Section 1 of the Constitution to read:

- 72 All seats for Senators members of Senate shall be reserved according to the following
- 73 criteria:
- 74 A. Seats shall be reserved for three (3) persons designated by the Senate as Holdover
- 75 Senators.

- 76 B. One (1) seat shall be reserved for each of the officers and Cabinet members of the
- Association, with the President and Treasurer being non-voting members.

6. Amend Article IV Section 3 of the Constitution to read:

79 All elective seats in the Senate shall be filled at an election held at the same time as the election for Association officers. That number of candidates for at-large senatorial seats 80 who receive the largest totals of votes shall be declared elected. 81 82 7. Amend Article IV Section 6 of the Constitution to read: The following will be grounds for removal of a Senator: 83 The failure to maintain a 2.50 cumulative grade point average; 84 85 The failure to fulfill prescribed *duties*.
