New Buisness:

1. Kitrina Miller came in and walked all of the justices through the parking rules and regulations. Then she explained what had happened in this case and why the parking committee decided to deny the appeal. They didn't appeal the citation because he wrongfully parked in a yellow lot and it clearly stated that he was to park in a green lot or green/yellow striped lot.

2. Terrance Brooks came in and explained how he didn't buy a parking pass at the beginning of the semester because he had night classes. The parking police do not monitor the lots after 5pm so it wasn't necessary. One of his professors asked him to come to campus during the day, so he went through his WSU account to purchase a day pass. He parked in a yellow lot because the map of the parking lots showed that visitors are allowed to park in a yellow lot and he believed he was a visitor because he's not normally there during the day.

- 3. Deliberations on the case began
 - a. Ben Spainhour went through the process that Terrance Brooks would go through to buy the day pass.
 - b. After all the justices watched the process, we determined that it was clear on where students are allowed to park.

- c. We then looked at the map Brooks would've looked at and unanimously decided that the map should be changed to say "non-WSU Student Visitors" instead of "Visitors" to get rid of any confusion.
- d. All of the justices agreed that the appeal should be denied due to how clear the process was.
