For Using Your VA Education Benefits

- Review and apply for VA Education Benefits
 - View Education Benefit Programs at gibill.va.gov or vets.gov
 - Apply for Education Benefits at vets.gov/education/apply/
- Apply for admission to Wichita State
 - Undergraduate Programs: wichita.edu/admissions
 - Graduate Programs: wichita.edu/graduate
- Verify residency status with WSU Office of the Registrar
 - Contact the Office of the Registrar to verify residency once you are admitted
 - To apply for Kansas residency, submit the Application for Kansas Resident Classification for Current Military Personnel/Spouse/Dependents and Eligible Veterans/Spouse/Dependents
- Schedule an academic advising appointment
 - Complete the Enrollment Certification Request form each semester you are using Education Benefits with your Academic Advisor
- Turn in the following documents to WSU Military & Veteran Services:
 - All forms can be found at wichita.edu/vaforms
 - Copy of Certificate of Eligibility (from Department of Veterans Affairs)
 - If transferring benefits from another school, submit a copy of Change of Place of Training VA Form 22-1995 (excluding Chapter 35) or VA Form 22-5495 (Chapter 35 Only)
 - Intent to Enroll form (from Wichita State)
 - Enrollment Certification Request form (from Wichita State), completed with Academic Advisor

Finding the Best Program For You

➤ Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33)

Servicemembers and veterans with at least 90 days of aggregate active duty service on or after 09/11/2001

Servicemembers still serving active duty

Veterans honorably discharged due to service-connected disability after 30 days

PERCENT OF MAXIMUM BENEFIT PAYABLE	100%	100%	90%	80%	70%	60%	50%	40%
Individuals serving an aggregate period of active duty after 09/11/2001:	At least 36 months	At least 30 continuous days and discharge due to service-connected disability	At least 30 months- <36 months	At least 24 months- <30 months	At least 18 months- <24 months	At least 12 months- <18 months	At least 6 months- <12 months	At least 90 days- < 6 months

➤ Post-9/11 Transfer of Entitlement

Eligible servicemembers may transfer all or some unused benefits to a spouse, one or more children, or any combination of spouse and children

➤ Post-9/11 Yellow Ribbon Program

Eligible servicemembers, veterans, and/or dependents who do not qualify for Kansas residency and are eligible for 100% Post-9/11 Education Benefits

➤ Montgomery GI Bill®—Active Duty (MGIB-AD Chapter 30)

Veterans and servicemembers with at least two years of active duty service

➤ Montgomery GI Bill® —Selected Reserve (MGIB-SR Chapter 1606)

Eligible members of the Selected Reserve, including Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard Reserves, and Army and Air National Guard

➤ Survivors and Dependents Educational Assistance Program (DEA Chapter 35)

Eligible dependents of veterans who are permanently and totally disabled due to a service-related condition, or who died while on active duty or as a result of a service-related condition

➤ Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (VR&E Chapter 31)

Veterans with service-connected disability who are seeking gainful employment
